## MOUNT TARRENGOWER CIRCUIT

Difficulty: Easier

Distance: 14.7 km

Vertical Metres: 192 m

Type: Off-bitumen (81% unpaved).

The approximate distance from the start is shown in km as [1.6].

## **Detailed Route:**

From the Maldon Post Office (corner of High St and Francis St), travel east along Francis St. Turn left into Templeton St and head north for 800 m before turning right into Parker St. In another 100 m turn left into Church St, cross Lowther St (C283), and then turn left into Back Cemetery Rd [1.6]. A pleasant 1.8 km downhill run takes you behind the golf course to Maldon Cemetery [3.4]. Turn left into Maldon-Shelbourne Rd (Nuggetty Rd) and follow to the intersection with Bridgewater-Maldon Rd (C282).

Cross the intersection (TAKE CARE!). Follow Watersons Rd for 1.3 km and turn left into Mount Back Rd [5.5]. Continue around the base of the mountain for 4.3 km until Parkins Reef Rd is reached [9.8]. Follow this road to rejoin the bitumen near the North British mine site and Carman's Tunnel. Continue along Parkins Reef Rd to the intersection with the Maldon-Newstead Rd (C283) [13.6] which takes you back into Maldon [14.7].
