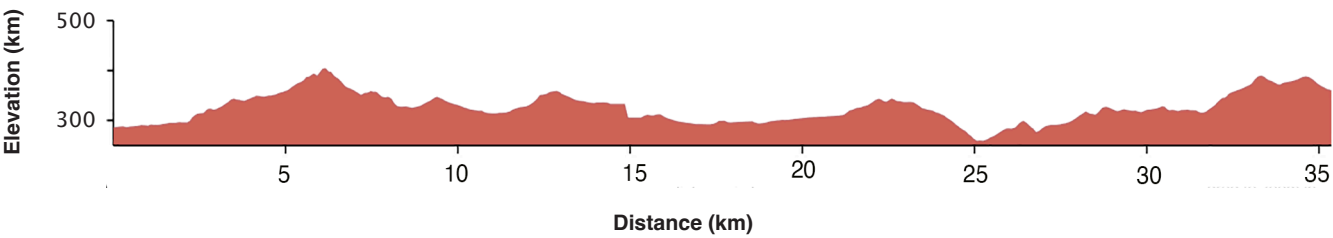


## G4 BARRY’S LOOP OF LANES (Castlemaine to Maldon)

A more challenging ride from Castlemaine to Maldon, through bush and farming land with scenic views. Mainly on gravel roads with low traffic volumes.

Difficulty: Hard      Distance: 35.4 km      Elevation Gain: 421 m



DISTANCE (km)	DIRECTIONS	NOTES
0	From Castlemaine Railway Station (east side) proceed through the nearby subway to the west side of the Railway Station (you may need to dismount).	<b>CARE!</b>
0.2	Right to Gingell Street.	
1.0	Right to Walker Street, then left to Downes Road, beside Castlemaine Botanical Gardens.	<b>CARE!</b>
1.9	Left to Froomes Road.	
2.4	Continue on Mary Street.	
2.7	Right to Odgers Road.	
4.7	Left to McManus Road.	
5.6	Right to Youngmans Track.	
6.3	Left to Escape Track.	
6.8	Left to Millard Track.	
8.3	Right to Woodbrook Road, then left to Lewis Road.	
10.7	Right to Ottreys Scrub Road.	
15.3	Left to Muckleford-Walmer Road.	<b>CARE!</b>
16.2	Right to Troys Road.	
17.6	Right to Gibbon Street.	
18.7	Left to Fogartys Gap Road then immediately right to Three Chain Road.	<b>CARE!</b>
21.1	Cross Bendigo-Maldon Road (C283).	<b>CARE!</b>
25.2	Left to McKnights Road.	
27.1	Left to Pollards Road.	
28.7	Right to Nuggetty Road.	
31.3	Left to Maldon-Shelbourne Road.	<b>CARE!</b>
31.6	Left to Back Cemetery Road.	
33.4	Right to Church Street.	
33.8	Cross Lowther Street/ Bendigo-Maldon Road (C283).	<b>CARE!</b>
34.0	Right to Franklin Street, then left to High Street.	<b>CARE!</b>
35.4	Cross High Street and arrive at Maldon Post Office.	<b>CARE!</b>
