


## G10 ROCK OF AGES

A very popular ride to two interesting sites just north of Maldon. Wonderful views. Mainly on gravel roads with low traffic volumes.

Difficulty: Easy    Distance: 9.9 km    Elevation Gain: 153 m



DISTANCE (km)	DIRECTIONS	NOTES
0	From Maldon Post Office (corner of High and Francis Streets), cross High Street and travel east along Francis Street.	<b>CARE!</b>
0.1	Left to Templeton Street.	
0.7	Right to Adair Street.	
0.8	Left to Church Street.	
1.4	Cross Lowther Street / Bendigo-Maldon Road (C283).	<b>CARE!</b>
2.2	Left to Davies Lane.	
3.5	Reach intersection with Nuggety Track and Jones Track. Take the LH fork uphill to Darky's Hut* (may need to dismount).	<b>STEEP!</b>
3.7	Reach Darky's Hut. Return to Nuggety Track.	
4.0	Follow Nuggety Track.	
4.8	Right to Rock of Ages Track.	
5.8	Reach Rock of Ages parking area.  Return on Rock of Ages Track.	
6.6	At intersection with Nuggety Track continue on Rock of Ages Track.	
7.2	Right to Davies Lane.	
7.2	Left to Church Street.	
7.7	At Bells Reef Road, Church Street becomes Reef Street.	
8.5	Cross Lowther Street/Bendigo-Maldon Road (C283).	<b>CARE!</b>
9.2	Continue on Reef Street, which turns right and becomes Main Street.	<b>CARE!</b>
9.3	Continue along Main Street.	
9.7	Right to High Street.	<b>CARE!</b>
9.9	Arrive at Maldon Post Office.	

\*Darky's Hut does not relate to an Indigenous person. Darky was the nickname of a miner who worked the nearby goldmine. The hut was built for him in 1984.
