


G14 CAIRN CURRAN CIRCUIT

A very popular circuit via Cairn Curran Reservoir through bush and farming land with scenic views. Mainly on gravel roads with low traffic volumes.

Difficulty: Medium Distance: 28.2 km Elevation Gain: 354 m



DISTANCE (km)	DIRECTIONS	NOTES
0	From Maldon Post Office (corner of High and Francis Streets), cross High Street and travel east along Francis Street.	CARE!
0.1	Left at Templeton Street.	
0.9	Right to Parker Street then left to Church Street.	
1.4	Cross Lowther Street/Bendigo-Maldon Road (C283).	CARE!
1.8	Left to Back Cemetery Road. This is a long downhill run to Maldon Cemetery with some rough sections.	CARE
3.6	Left to Maldon-Shelbourne Road (Nuggety Road).	CARE!
4.4	Cross Bridgewater-Maldon Road (C282) to Watersons Road.	CARE!
5.3	Continue past Mount Back Road.	
11.6	Left to Cairn Curran Road (sealed).	
12.0	Take central road which loops down towards the reservoir and past the sailing club.	
13.2	Turn right back to Cairn Curran Road and ride south beside the reservoir.	
14.6	Turn left to Whitlocks Road (unmarked), initially a rough track.	
16.9	At intersection with Back Cairn Curran Road, continue on South Parkins Reef Road.	
20.6	Right to Skinners Road which becomes Sells Lane.	
23.4	Cross Maldon-Newstead Road (C283) to Barham Road. There is poor visibility at this intersection.	CARE!
	Continue on Barham Road, which becomes Popeks Road.	
27.2	Right to Maldon-Newstead Road (C283).	CARE!
27.5	Continue on High Street.	
28.2	Arrive at Maldon Post Office.
