


## G14V CAIRN CURRAN CIRCUIT – LONGER VARIANT

A slightly longer variant of the Cairn Curran circuit, through bush and farming land with scenic views. Mainly on gravel roads with low traffic volumes. Can be a very pleasant ride early in the morning or late in the afternoon.

**Difficulty: Medium      Distance: 33.4 km      Elevation Gain: 394 m**



DISTANCE (km)	DIRECTIONS	NOTES
0.0	From Maldon Post Office (corner of High and Francis Streets), cross High Street and travel east along Francis Street.	<b>CARE!</b>
0.1	Left at Templeton Street.	
0.9	Right to Parker Street, then left to Church Street.	
1.4	Cross Lowther Street/Bendigo-Maldon Road (C283).	<b>CARE!</b>
1.8	Left to Back Cemetery Road. This is a long downhill run to Maldon Cemetery with some rough sections.	<b>CARE!</b>
3.6	Left to Maldon-Shelbourne Road (Nuggety Road).	<b>CARE!</b>
4.4	Cross Bridgewater-Maldon Road (C282) to Watersons Road.	<b>CARE!</b>
11.6	Left to Cairn Curran Road (sealed).	
12.0	Take central road which loops down towards the reservoir and past the sailing club.	
13.2	Turn right back to Cairn Curran Road and ride south along the reservoir.	
14.6	Turn left to Whitlocks Road (unmarked), initially a rough track.	
16.9	At intersection with Back Cairn Curran Road, continue on South Parkins Reef Road.	
17.8	Right to Tarrengower School Road.	
20.9	Left to Goughs Range Road.	
25.1	Right to Maldon-Newstead Road (C283).	<b>CARE!</b>
25.8	Hard left to Sandy Creek Road.	
29.2	About 300 m past Mia Mia Track take unnamed track left and across ford over Sandy Creek.	
29.4	Right to Barham Road, which becomes Popeks Road.	
32.0	Right to Maldon-Newstead Road (C283).	<b>CARE!</b>
32.6	Continue on High Street.	
33.4	Arrive at Maldon Post Office.
